# AIA Lower Rio Grande Valley 2025 DESIGN AWARDS

## ENTRY FORM

### ELIGIBILITY

Entries must be submitted by an AIA.LRGV and Texas Board of Architectural Examiners Registered Architect or by an AIA.LRGV Intern Associate Member at the time the project was executed. Where responsibility for a project is shared, all participants who contributed to the work must be credited. Projects must be submitted in the name of the firm or intern associate member that executed the project.

### PDF PRESENTATION

Provide one presentation in PDF format with no more than 15 pages/slides. The file name should be the same as the project name (for example, "UnityPark.pdf"). Do not identify the entrant or firm on the PDF file. Presentations should be concise and of high graphic quality and may not contain sound, animation, video clips, panorama movies, or hyperlinks. Each PDF presentation file should not exceed 20 MB. Pages should be oriented horizontally (landscape)

### PDF PROJECT DATA SHEET

Provide a one-page (8.5"x 11") PDF document containing 1-4 representative images (photographs or drawings), along with bullet points and a brief paragraph describing the project, all on a white background. The narrative must describe the project in no more than 300 words. Include program requirements, design solutions and project objectives. Do not identify the entrant or firm on the PDF file.

### ENTRY DEADLINE

All entries must be received no later than  
**5:00 PM CT on Wednesday, November 12, 2025**

### JURY

Three to four experienced jurors, as selected by the Design Award Committee, will serve via an online jury process.

### PUBLICATION

For publicity purposes, winning entries must submit a single high-resolution digital image of the project for publication in TxA Media, the AIA.LRGV Newsletter and Website. Images must be in JPEG or TIFF format, no larger than 3 MB, and at least 5 inches on the shortest side at 300 dpi. File name: ProjectName\_PhotoBy\_PhotographerCredit

### AWARD CATEGORIES (CHECK ONE APPLICABLE TO YOUR PROJECT)

**GENERAL DESIGN** (*general, interior, restoration, urban design/planning*)  
Awarded to one built project of the most exemplary design quality, at the discretion of the Jury. The two award subcategories within this category are:  
**HONOR-** Top honors, only given to those projects that exceed all expectations in every measurable criterion.  
**MERIT-** Second honors, innovative high-quality design that stands out from all other submissions received.

### 25+ YEAR AWARD

The 25+ Year Award honors distinguished Lower Rio Grande Valley architecture of enduring significance. This award recognizes a project completed over 25 years ago and has retained its central form and character with architectural integrity of the project intact. The project must be completed on or before December 31, 2000.

### SPARK AWARD

Un-built projects of any type, including purely theoretical, visionary projects, with or without clients. The construction of the submitted project does not need to be foreseen at the time of entry. There are no restrictions on the individuals, teams, or firms to submit and there are no restrictions on the location of the project. The intent is to invite work by participating architects, interns, and associate members of the AIA-LRGV.
