- Transportation from SPI (Attendees can hop on several cars and carpool to the bridge in Brownsville/rental passenger van/meet at Jacob Brown Auditorium Parking Lot - TBD)
- Gateway International Bridge will be the port of entry by foot.
- Colegio de Arquitectos del Noreste de Tamaulipas (CANT) members will receive tour attendees at the bridge and will have transportation vans to be used throughout the duration of the tour.
- The majority of the sights to be visited are situated in the "GREEN ZONE"; this is a secured and protected area by the U.S. Government. Additional security will also be provided.
- Attendees must have either a VALID US PASSPORT or VALID ID + BIRTH CERTIFICATE for re-entry to the US.
